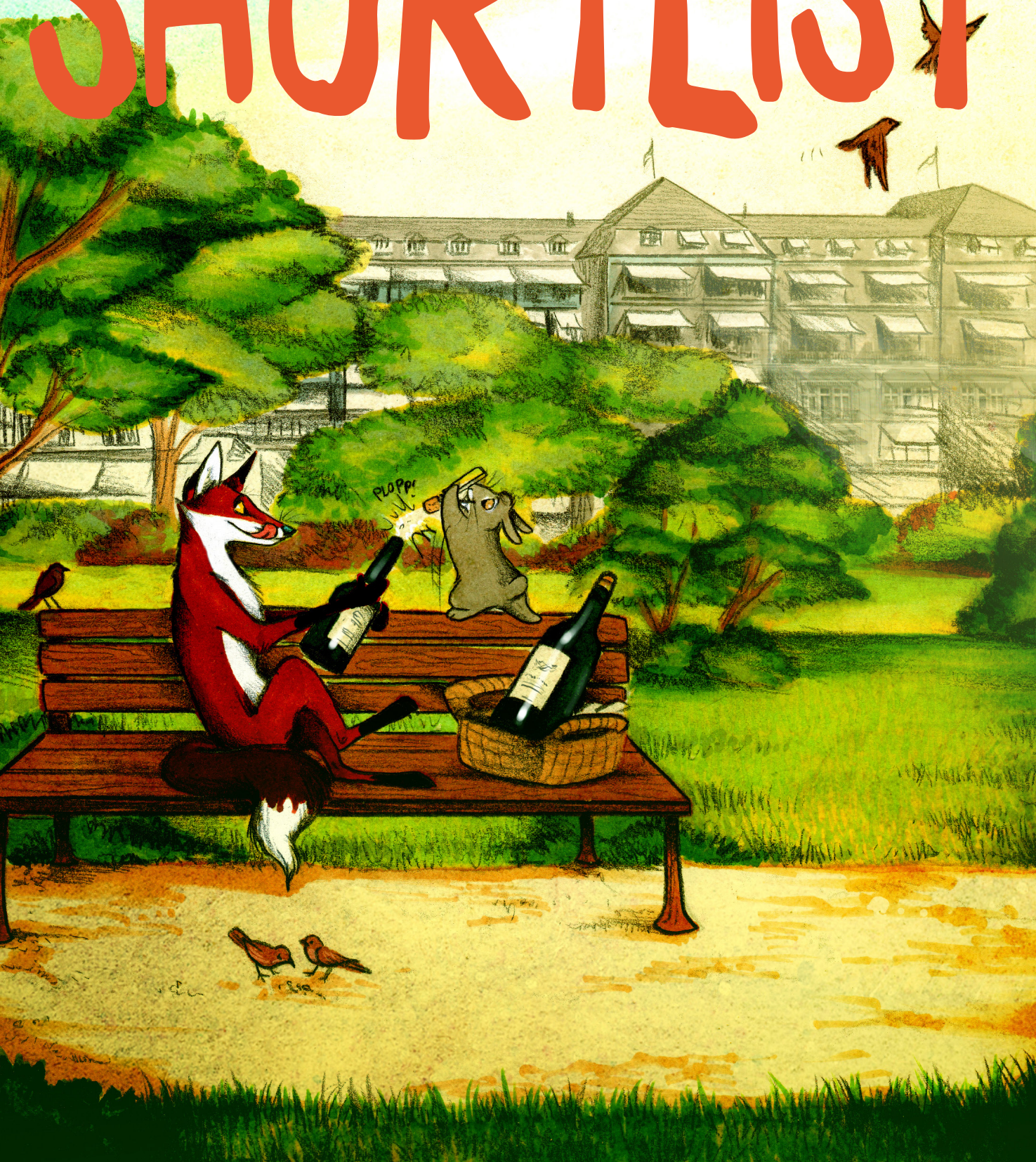


# SHORTLIST







Dear readers,

Trends come and go, and this also applies to the wine industry. In addition to natural wines, rosés and sparkling wines, it is above all organic or biodynamic wines that can be found more and more frequently on the shelves. But what exactly do these terms mean and how do they differ?

Organic viticulture does not use artificial fertilisers and synthetic pesticides, which deliberately damage the environment. Instead, winegrowers use plant protection methods that have as little impact on the environment as possible. Natural composting and greening between the rows of vines also play a major role. The aim is to strengthen both the soil and the local ecosystem and make the vines more resilient.

Biodynamic viticulture takes an even broader perspective and views the vineyard as a holistic system. In addition to organic practices, special natural preparations consisting of substances such as horn manure and minerals are used to promote the vitality of the vineyard. Decisions here are also guided by the lunar calendar, based on the assumption that cosmic rhythms influence plant growth and wine quality. For example, the wines are only bottled during certain phases of the moon.

Whether organic or biodynamic wines are ultimately better than conventional wines is open to question. In this edition of the shortlist, you have the opportunity to conduct a little self-experiment: Some of the wines have been produced organically or biodynamically, while the rest have been produced conventionally. You can recognise the organically

produced wines by our organic symbol. Taste your way through the menu and find out whether you can taste the difference.

For inspiration, I have selected three organic wines that are not only produced in an environmentally friendly way, but also taste excellent. The 2022 Ökonomierat Rebholz Im Sonnenschein Pinot Blanc comes from one of the most famous vineyards in the Palatinate. The vines, some of which are over 40 years old, produce expressive wines.

The 2021 4 Kilos comes from the island of Mallorca and was made from the rare Callet grape variety. The 2016 Château Pontet Canet 5ème Grand Cru Classé is one of the great classics from Bordeaux. Horses are used in the vineyards here to protect the soil and occasionally add a little natural fertiliser ... you know what I mean.

We hope you enjoy reading and, above all, savouring our wines.

# Louis Roederer

Louis Roederer is one of the best houses in Champagne. The company was originally founded under the name Dubois Père & Fils. When Louis Roederer took over from his uncle in 1832, he changed his name to prompt and focused on growth and quality. As a result of this strategy, Louis Roederer is still one of the largest owners of vineyards in Champagne today and produces some of the most sought-after wines in the region.

# Bollinger

The history of Bollinger began in 1829 with Athanase de Villermont. He joined forces with the German emigrant Joseph Bollinger and the wine enthusiast Paul Renaudin and they founded the champagne house Renaudin-Bollinger & Cie, which became Bollinger over the decades. The family-run house does not stand still, but is constantly working on new projects, from sustainable viticulture to perfecting the ageing of the base wines in barriques.

# Rosé Champagne

Did you know that two of the three grape varieties used for champagne are red? For most champagnes, the red varieties Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier are pressed white, resulting in a light-colored champagne. Rosé Champagne is not only different in color. The wines smell of strawberries and raspberries and are more opulent and richer.

# Pearl & Sparkling wine

Carbon dioxide makes sparkling and semi-sparkling wines what they are. This molecule, which we produce as a by-product of breathing, breathes life into wines, makes them lively and makes life a little easier to bear. There are now excellent sparkling and semi-sparkling wines all over the world and we have put together a selection from Germany, France and Italy. The difference between sparkling and semi-sparkling wines is mainly determined by the pressure in the bottle. Sparkling wines have less than 2.5 bar pressure, while sparkling wines must have over 3 bar pressure in the bottle. This is more pressure than a car tire should have, so watch out when the cork pops!

# Riesling

No other grape variety is so clearly synonymous with German wine. Coveted by wine drinkers on every continent, 100 years ago it produced the most expensive wines in the world, and even today it is still one of the highest quality white grape varieties, even if it lags somewhat behind the wines from Bordeaux and Burgundy in terms of price. I have tasted Rieslings all over the world, but nowhere does this grape variety feel as at home as in Germany.

# Pinot Gris

Do you have a Pinot Gris? Hardly any other grape variety is as trendy as Pinot Gris, and there are some good reasons for this. A selection of these reasons can be found here. With aroma and power, Pinot Gris can produce great wines, especially here in Baden.

407, A lively and fruity Pinot Gris from Weinhaus Heger.

354, The Achkarrener Schlossberg is located to the west of the Winklerberg. It is partly very steep and is one of the warmest locations in Germany.

# Pinot Blanc

Pinot Blanc is the brother of Pinot Gris. While Pinot Gris has colored berry skins, Pinot Blanc is very light in color. Not everyone can tease out what makes this grape variety so special. But the following winegrowers have managed it.

410, What the brothers Tobias and Björn Knewitz have achieved in recent years is remarkable. The small winery is one of Rheinhessen's rising stars and this Pinot Blanc impresses with its freshness and elegance.

# Chardonnay

If there is one grape variety that can challenge Riesling for the title of king of white wines, it is Chardonnay. In Burgundy, some of the most complex wines the world has ever seen are made from Chardonnay. In Germany, Chardonnay is also being planted more and more frequently.

# Domaine Leflaive




This small wine estate in Burgundy has a history dating back to 1717. In the 20<sup>th</sup> century, however, the family vineyard worked its way up to the top of the wine world and the Chardonnays from Domaine Leflaive are among the most sought-after wines in France. It has long been important to the Leflaive family that their work is as environmentally friendly as possible, and so they were a pioneer of biodynamic viticulture in Burgundy.

Domaine Leflaive's most famous vineyards are located in the Côte de Beaune around the Le Montrachet site. The neighbouring vineyards all have ‘Montrachet’ in their names. You could say that this area of Burgundy is the centre of the Chardonnay world, because nowhere else are such high-quality and excellent wines made from this variety as here.

# Hospices de Beaune

The bells are ringing and the atmosphere in the ‘Halles de Beaune’ is tense: wine merchants, journalists and connoisseurs are following the traditional wine auction of the Hospices de Beaune. We from Brenners Park-Hotel & Spa were also there, well prepared with an auction catalogue and bidding sign - and determined not to return empty-handed.

Wines from the best vineyards in Burgundy have been auctioned here for over 160 years - in aid of charitable causes. The Hospices de Beaune, once a hospital, now owns an impressive variety of vineyards. Its origins date back to 1443, when Chancellor Nicolas Rolin founded the Hôtel-Dieu as a refuge for the needy.

The atmosphere at the 161st auction was exuberant - especially for the ‘Pièce des Présidents’, which sold for 800,000 euros. We were also successful and so today we can present the 2021 Monthélie Les Duresses Cuvée Lebelin to you for the first time. The wine is named after Etienne Lebelin, the first hospital chaplain of the Hospice de la Charité. This comes from a cooler site and, according to Burgundy expert Jasper Morris MW, has produced an aromatic wine with a fine and elegant finish in 2021.

## Orange wine

Orange wines are among the most hotly debated wine styles in the world. These are white wines that are left in contact with the grape skins. Sometimes this process changes the colour to a more or less subtle orange. However, the aromas and flavour always change. The aromas and tannins contained in the grape skin transform the wine into something completely new. Although this technique has been practised in some regions of the world for centuries, it is now making a comeback in the established wine world and adding a new style to it.

# Domaine de la Romanée Conti

If the wine world had to agree on one winery that represents the pinnacle of quality, it would perhaps be Domaine de la Romanée-Conti. Among connoisseurs, the winery is simply abbreviated as DRC, and these three letters carry a lot of weight. The domaine is located in the sleepy village of Vosne-Romanée, close to some of the best vineyards in Burgundy. DRC's eight Grand Cru vineyards are farmed organically and with great attention to detail. On my last visit, I was even able to observe how the vineyards are worked with horses to protect the soil.

# California Dreamin

# Pinot Noir

Pinot Noir or 'Spätburgunder' is one of the most influential grape varieties in the world. Not only is it directly related to Pinot Blanc and Pinot Gris, but it is also a parent of a large number of now established grape varieties. Great Pinot Noirs are hard to beat in terms of intensity, complexity and longevity. Burgundy is considered the cradle of Pinot Noir, but Germany also produces some of the best wines from this grape variety today.

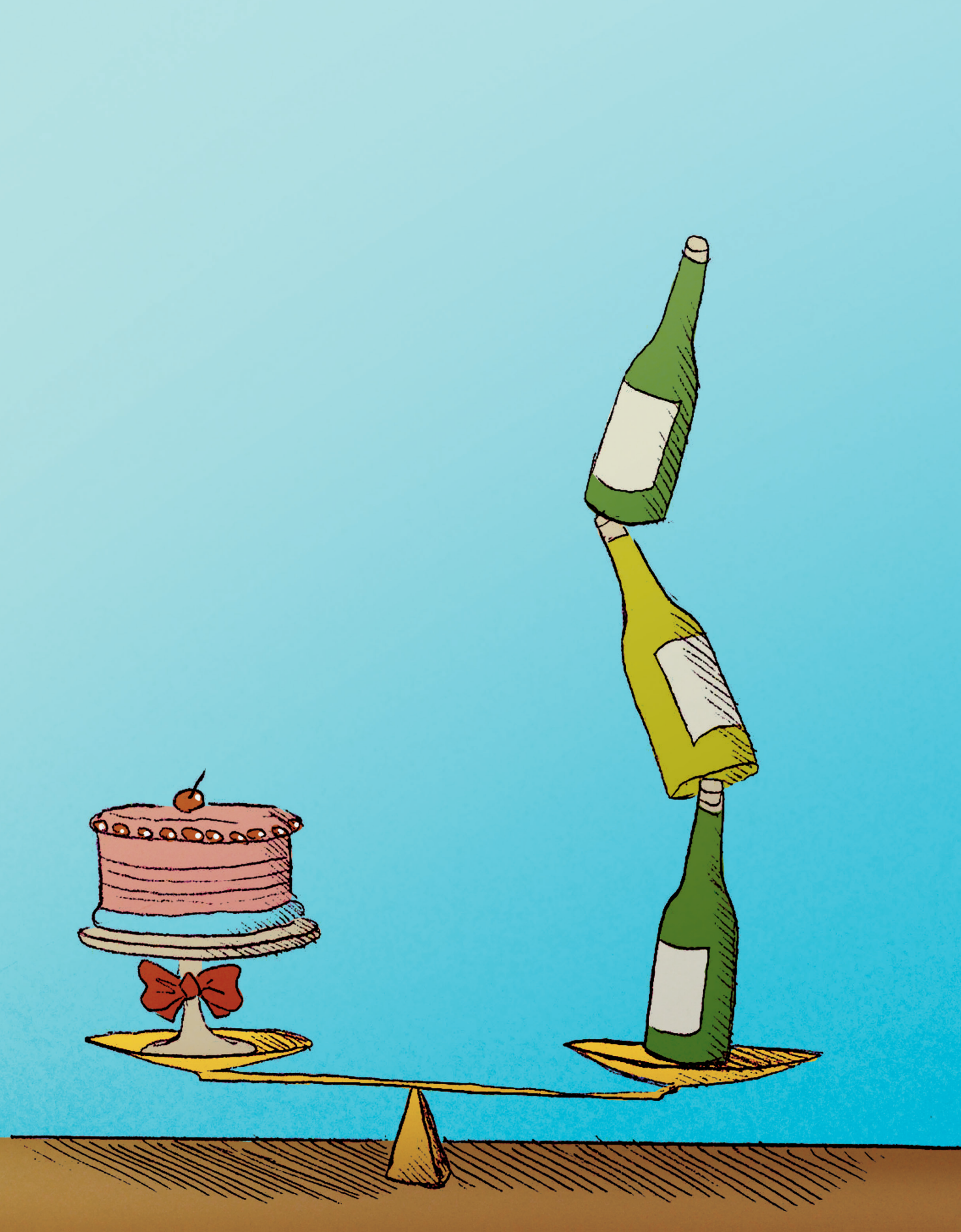


